
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
#### Dimensional drawing in mm




## Ordering codes and packing advices

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#### **Cautions and warnings**

- Surge arresters must not be operated directly in power supply networks.
- The follow current must be limited so that the arrester can be properly extinguished when the surge has decayed. The arrester might otherwise heat up and ignite adjacent components.
- Surge arresters may become hot in case of longer periods of current stress (danger of burning).
- Surge arresters may be used only within their specified values. In case of overload, the lead contacts may fail or the component may be destroyed.
- Surge arresters must be handled with care and must not be dropped.
- Damaged surge arresters must not be re-used.

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
